



Savings Makes Similes (and Metaphors): A Figurative Language Game

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Contents:

1. 48 simile and metaphor coins
2. Piggy banks and one main bank

Directions:

Print, cut out, and laminate all coins, the main bank, as well as one piggy bank per player.

Shuffle all coins and place them face down on the main bank. A student draws a coin and completes the simile or metaphor. If completed correctly, the student puts the coin on his piggy bank. If incorrect, the student returns the coin to the main bank. The student with the most coins at the end of the time wins.

Alternate idea: Use the Fisher-Price® Laugh and Learn piggy bank toy. Tape my coins inside the toy's coins, and place them in the toy as completed.
